MEETING MINUTES

Our President, Mike Massey started the meeting on 3/1/2012 at 6:07pm at the Library with 8 members present and no visitors.

Minutes from the previous meeting were accepted as printed in the February newsletter.

Treasurer's Report – The treasurer's report shows a balance of \$2194.53 in the checking account.

Safety report – Wayne discussed a video posted to a forum regarding a “Training” method for helicopters. It seems that cables fastened to the skids were used to keep the heli under control. It appeared that nothing was stopping the heli from tilting which could cause the main rotor to come in contact with the cables, resulting in self destruction & sending parts flying. This is one of those times where if something seems to be wrong with the idea then it probably is.

Web report – Our webmaster has the page moved to his servers and is currently up and running with the same functionality that it had previously. Over the coming weeks the page will be converted to PHP, existing bugs worked out and new functionality added.

Ryan talked had the Facebook site complete and has been posting items to it. Everyone is encouraged to visit it & put up pictures, comments, etc.

Board report – In Peter's absence the report was given by Dave which covered:

- Membership cards should be given out the current members (this was done at the beginning of the meeting. Those not present will be mailed at a later date).

New Business:

- Wayne brought drawings for a 72.82" wingspan Piper Aztec that he plans to build from foam. He intends to power it with 2-2200mah LiPo's and wants to get started over the weekend.
