MEETING MINUTES

Old Business:

- The indoor season has been established (tentatively) as the first Sunday of each month (mostly) from 7:00pm until 10:00pm. The new cost will be \$15. Tabled Items:

- An expansion to the storage shed, changing it from an 8'x8' to an 8'x16' with an 8'x16' pavilion (essentially a 16'x16' structure). The cost of such a change was calculated to be approximately \$1200. At this point this will be tabled pending more information as well as additional funds. At this point the membership size may not warrant this project. The grant for this has been submitted to the AMA and we've received \$141.90 to be used for field upgrades.
- Safety nets need to be repaired. These will be worked on as time permits.

New Business:

- John P brought up the idea of a swap meet at our field, but it was decided that participation would likely be quite low. Attending the Midland event was determined to be a better idea.
- The non-profit corporation paperwork came. There's nothing unusual so it will be filled out and sent in.
