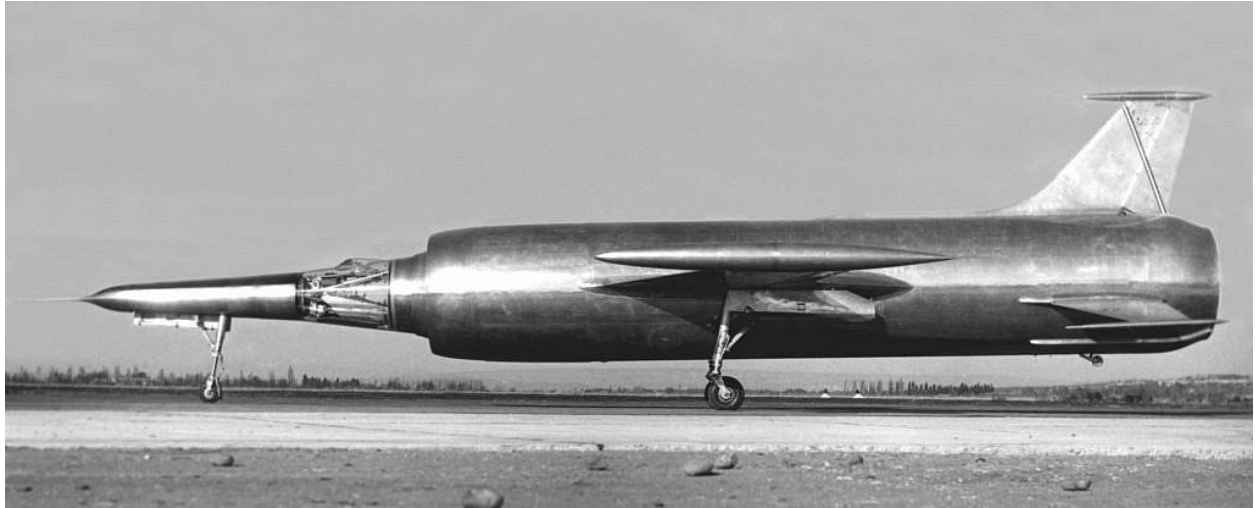
Airplane contest: There was no airplane contest last month
