## Safety report – Reminder time

- The Safety Coordinator is an educator. It's everyone's responsibility to keep the field safe, to abide by the rules and to enforce the rules. If someone is doing something that could be considered unsafe, it's YOUR responsibility to remind them how it should be done.
- There MUST be no flying or taxiing behind the flight line. This can quickly cause a dangerous situation that is easily avoided.
- If anyone needs to retrieve their aircraft after an unexpected "landing" in the crops, be careful! It's easy to damage the crops by stepping on them so use your head when walking through them. It's late in the year and not much is left, but remember this for next summer.
- Plane restraints must be used. NO EXCEPTIONS! The starting stands have built in restraints, but when starting your plane on the ground, it must be restrained.
- While it might be necessary to be on the runway during takeoff or to retrieve an aircraft, please make every effort to get off the runway as quickly as possible. Other pilots are delayed from taking off or landing until the runway is clear.


